# Year 11 and 13 Students

As a result of COVID-19, this year the public examination results will be sent out to students' **school email addresses** on the mornings of Thursday 13 August (Year 13) and Thursday 20 August (Year 11). It is, therefore, essential that the students ensure they are able to access their school email address and know their password.

As part of the testing process for the publication of the examination results, students were sent a test email to their school email address at 9am on Wednesday morning (8 July). It is essential that they have checked this carefully to ensure that all the subjects for which they are entered are listed and that their personal details are correct. Please note that there was an error on the Year 13 email that said results would be published on 20 August. Rest assured that the date for A level publication will be Thursday 13 August as outlined above. We will also include the results of Extended Project Qualifications in the results email – for some students these did not appear on the test email.

If there are any inaccuracies in terms of their personal details and subjects listed, they **MUST** let Mr Holland know **ASAP** (<u>iamie.holland@carres.uk</u>) so that the system can be updated to ensure they receive accurate information on results day.
