Dear Parent/Carer

We are proposing to give the Year 13 Geography students an opportunity to attend Field Trips on **Monday 12 October and Wednesday 14 October 2020**. The trips will be to collect data from locations in Lincoln or the Lincolnshire Coast (Skegness). The trips will run from **8.45am until 3.45pm**. Students will be using some of this data within their Geographical Investigation worth 20% of their A Level grade; it is, therefore, essential that all students attend at least one of the fieldtrips.

During the visits the students will spend the days working in small groups, collecting information to be processed within the classroom. They will need to bring either money to buy lunch or a packed lunch. The trips are non school uniform.

In order to cover transport, the cost of the trip is £15. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988 we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
