

Behaviour and Consequence Ladder for outreach sessions and clubs

0	Children on Task			No Action Required
1	 Not giving coaches personal s Touching or playing with equip 	 Deliberate time wasting Unsporting behaviour towards other teams. Not giving coaches personal space. Touching or playing with equipment when asked not to do so. 		- Verbal warning – clear explanation of consequence (choices) - Stop and wait
2	- Play lighting - Deliberately trying to get someone into trouble - Talking when adults are talking Behaviour including: - Speaking when an adult is speaking 3 times Consistently messing around when should be on task - Making rude noises on purpose - Squabbling - Making fun of others - Name Calling - Constantly distracting others Behaviour including: - Continuous disruption - Selective - Selective - Friendships		2	- Time out of session. When the child comes back into the session they will be expected to be on task. If there is more of a repeat of level 2 behaviour then a level 3 punishment will be enforced Informal contact with teachers as appropriate (e.g. discussion)
3	Behaviour including: - Continuous disruption - Lack of respect to adults and other children - Maliciousness (elements of bullying) - Swearing out of frustration in a game.	Bullying - Selective - Friendships - Deliberate exclusion - Name calling	3	- Child to be removed from the session Contact with parents and teacher
4	Behaviours including: Refusal to comply (ignoring an adult) - Answering back - Spitting at someone - Swearing aggressively at some one Fighting	Bullying - Repeated malicious name calling and/or comments - Physical violence - Sexism - Racism - Xenophobic comments - Homophobic comments	4	 Regular display of level 4 behaviour requires contact with head teacher and parent. During this contact, teaches and coaches will discuss the following: Child suspended from next session Child not selected to represent the school until an improvement in behaviour is evident Child removed from club for rest of term. All comments to be reported to the school or parent if taking place at holiday activities.
