Dear Parent/Carer

We are proposing to take the Year 12 Geography students on two Field Trips on **Monday 19 June and Thursday 22 June 2017.** The trip on 19 June will be to collect data in several parts of Hull and will be from 8am to 6pm. The trip on 22 June will be to collect data from locations on the Norfolk Coast and will also be from 8am to 6pm. Students will be using some of this data within their Geographical Investigation worth 20% of their A Level grade; it is, therefore, essential that all students attend.

During the visit the students will spend both days working in small groups, collecting information to be processed within the classroom. They will need to bring either money to buy lunch or a packed lunch on the Hull trip and they will need a packed lunch on the Coast trip as there will be nowhere to buy food. Both trips are non school uniform.

In order to cover transport, the combined cost of both trips is £18. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988 we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
