- Depart from Studio Tour 5pm
- Return to Carre's circa 8pm (parents required to collect students from Carre's)

- Cost £30 (includes entrance ticket and transport)

Students will require money to purchase food and drink at the studio or a packed lunch and tea. Students may also wish to bring spending money should they wish to purchase items from the gift shop at the end of the tour. Students may wear 'civvies' but may need a waterproof coat as a small part of the tour is outside. Parents and carers should be aware that students will not be under close supervision by members of staff during the majority of the visit. However, they will be required to be in groups of AT LEAST two people. The studio tour is enclosed so it is safe for the boys to explore at their own pace.
